

NOTICE: IMPORTANT HEALTH COVERAGE TAX DOCUMENTS

This notice provides important information about your right to request and receive IRS Forms 1095-B and 1095-C. These forms provide proof of minimum essential coverage under the Affordable Care Act (ACA). You do not need to attach Forms 1095-B or 1095-C to your tax returns.

Please read the information in this notice carefully to understand your right to request and receive these forms.

In 2024, the Paperwork Burden Reduction Act amended the health insurance coverage reporting requirements under the ACA. Prior to this amendment, the ACA required plan sponsors and employers to send tax forms showing proof of minimum essential coverage (IRS Forms 1095-B and 1095-C) to covered individuals by January 31 of the year following the year for which a return was made.

Under the amendments implemented by the Paperwork Burden Reduction Act, plan sponsors and employers are no longer required to send IRS Forms 1095-B and 1095-C to plan participants and/or employees unless a covered individual affirmatively requests a copy. Accordingly, the IATSE Local 22 Welfare Fund will not automatically send Forms 1095-B and 1095-C for calendar year 2025. **If you would like to receive a copy of Forms 1095-B and/or 1095-C for calendar year 2025 for your records, you must contact the Fund Office to request a copy of these forms.**

If requested, the IATSE Local 22 Welfare Fund must provide the forms within 30 days after the date of the request.
